Fundraising meal for the Friends of Khristiya Seva Niketan Hospital, (KSN)

Monday 23rd September 2024 7pm, £25 (see flyer)

KSN Hospital in Sarenga, West Bengal, India, was established in 1914 by Dr Caleb Davis, a Welsh Methodist missionary doctor. The hospital is a not-for-profit organisation providing essential health care to the local community of farmers and tribal communities. Financial resources are limited and KSN is committed to providing affordable healthcare. The hospital also supports a nurses' training school and the Marshal Duar Hostel, which provides safe accommodation for local girls, whose families are struggling to care for them.

Friends of KSN Hospital is a UK based charity set up to support the hospital's life transforming work. The charity was established in 2021 at the instigation of the Rev Melanie Smith. Laura Marlow from Lancaster Road and Rosemary Milns from Christ Church URCs are two of the trustees and were part of a group that visited the hospital in 2019.

KSN Hospital has a number of projects underway at the present time, including the building of a blood bank, (which will also be the venue for blood donations) and the installation of an oxygen concentrator so that oxygen can be piped to the operating theatre and the wards and remove the dependence on cylinders. They also need to upgrade their electricity supply line and wiring. The blood bank building is now complete, but there is still a long list of equipment required, some costs under £5, others over £1,000.

The meal at Anokhi Restaurant in Winchmore Hill is to raise funds for this charity and as well as delicious food, there will be a raffle. Anokhi are giving a special price on the food, so that as much money as possible can be raised, so it would be great to fill the restaurant!
